ESC, A&WMA Scholarship Application

**Completed Package Due: November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

**Description:** The Eastern Sierra Chapter of the Air & Waste Management Association (ESC, A&WMA) is offering two merit-based scholarships, in the amount of \$750 each, for the Spring 2018 term for one undergraduate and one graduate student. For students who are enrolled in engineering or science majors with an emphasis on the environment at either the University of Nevada, Reno (UNR), Truckee Meadows Community College (TMCC) or Western Nevada College (WNC). Graduate students must be enrolled in a program with an emphasis on environmental studies.

**Qualifications:** To be eligible to apply, you must:

- Be currently enrolled in good standing as a declared undergraduate/graduate major in engineering or the sciences at UNR, TMCC or WNC and have completed at least 30 credits so far for undergraduate.
- Be enrolled as a full time (12 or more credits) undergraduate student or at least 6 credits for graduate student.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.00 for undergraduates and 3.50 for graduate students, or higher, and not be on academic probation or suspension.

**Instructions:** Submit the following materials in your complete application package, assembled in the order shown:

- A one-page letter of application, addressed to the ESC, A&WMA Board of Directors, explaining your background and interests in promoting a sense of environmental responsibility in your professional or academic life.
- Unofficial copy of your transcript.
- One letter of recommendation from a person who can verify your commitment to the environmental field, e-mailed directly from person recommending, not from applicant.

**Electronically compile all materials as a PDF and e-mail your completed application package to [eastern.sierra.awma@gmail.com](mailto:eastern.sierra.awma@gmail.com) by November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

**Evaluation:** To rate well in the application process, your letter of application should be well-informed with specific information about environmental professions and how you anticipate making a difference in the environmental field either through your personal life or career.

The ESC, A&WMA Board of Directors will evaluate submitted applications. You will then be notified whether or not you have received the scholarship award. The scholarship recipient will also receive 1 year of student membership to the A&WMA giving the student access to benefits such as access to job announcements, networking opportunities and more.
