## INSIGHTS FROM THE HIGHEST WEATHER STATIONS IN THE WORLD

High-mountain regions serve as essential water towers that sustain hundreds of millions of people living downstream. Basic understanding of the extreme climates at the highest elevations of the planet, however, has been lacking due to a nearly complete absence of weather stations. Nevada State Climatologist Baker Perry will discuss the rationale, challenges and insights from new weather station networks on Mount Everest in the Nepal Himalaya and the Andes of Bolivia, Chile and Peru.
